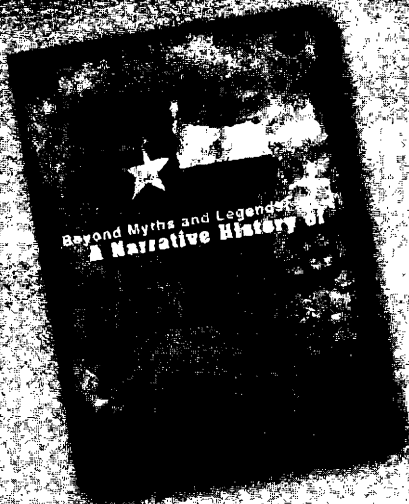

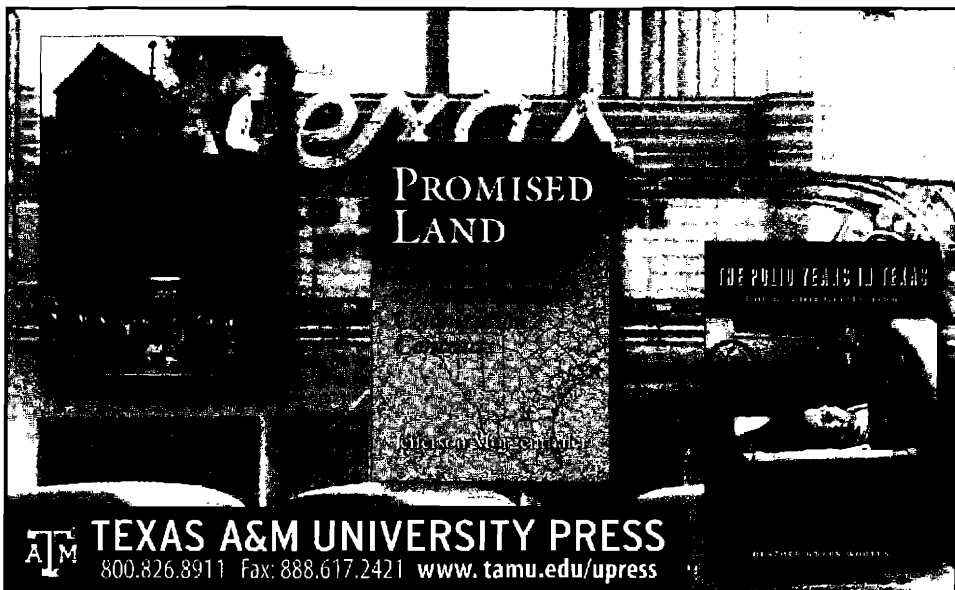
## True Texas
