

As is true of much folklore, the origins of the stories of *The 1,001 Nights*, sometimes called *The Arabian Nights*, are obscure and widely varied. They come not just from the Middle East but also from a huge swath of Asia as well as North and East Africa. European translators may even have added a few. The tales chosen from Sir Richard Francis Burton's version by the great Chicago-based playwright and director Mary Zimmerman for this dramatization seem to have been selected especially for their strangeness and ability to surprise and intrigue American audiences. Like the better-known "Aladdin and his Magic Lamp," "Sinbad the Sailor" and "Ali Baba and the Forty Thieves," they are part of our global heritage, and we hope you enjoy our re-telling of them this evening.

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**Mary Zimmerman** is the recipient of a 1998 MacArthur Fellowship, the 2002 Tony Award for Best Director of a Play and numerous Joseph Jefferson Awards (including Best Production and Best Direction) for her theatre work in Chicago. She is an Artistic Associate of Goodman Theatre, a member of Lookingglass Theatre Company and a professor of performance studies at Northwestern University. Ms. Zimmerman adapted and directed *Metamorphoses*, which appeared on Broadway, at Lookingglass Theatre Company, Off Broadway and at other major regional theatres. She has directed her many other plays throughout the U.S. and at the Wuzhen Theatre Festival in China. She created a new opera with Philip Glass, Galileo Galilei, and a stage adaptation of *The Jungle Book*. Ms. Zimmerman has directed Shakespeare's *Henry VIII* and *Measure for Measure* at the Public Theatre's Shakespeare in the Park.
