


# Mississippi Timber Removals: A Ten-year (1970-1979) Presentation

Mississippi is a major producer of manufactured forest products, and most of the timber required by Mississippi's forest industry is produced and harvested within the State. A severance tax on timber harvested in Mississippi is paid to the Mississippi State Tax Commission, and annual reports of timber removals are prepared by the Commission.

Timber removal information in a consolidated form is needed by public and private analysts in forecasting long-term trends in timber availability. This report presents (1) a consolidation of the Tax Commission reports for the 1970s and (2) a general overview of timber removal trends in that decade.

The estimates of volume removals presented are considered conservative because some removals may not have been reported for tax purposes. The estimated trends in timber removals assume that the ratio of reported harvests to unreported harvests was constant during the decade.

Trends in timber removals by product groups are presented statewide and by U.S. Forest Service Survey regions (Figure 1). Annual removals from each county in the decade also are presented. The product groups are pine timber, hardwood timber, pine pulpwood and hardwood pulpwood.



## Trends in Timber Harvests

Pine timber removals include lumber, sawlogs, poles, piling and posts. Lumber is reported in actual board measure, and log volumes are converted to actual board measure by applying a 20% overrun factor to the Doyle board foot log rule.




Figure 2. Mississippi pine timber removals reported for severance taxes by year and region

Pine timber harvests in Mississippi followed a generally upward trend during the 1970s except for a decline of about 20% from 1974 to 1975 (Figure 2). Large increases in annual cutting have occurred in Mississippi since 1975, and the 1979 pine timber harvest of 1,246 million board feet (MMBF) was 58% above the 1970 level of 789 MMBF. The Central Region led in pine timber removals in the 1970s, with volume harvested nearly doubling over the decade. The North Region continued to rank fourth in pine timber production during the decade, but the annual volume removed tripled over the 1970 level of 46 MMBF.





Figure 3. Mississippi hardwood timber removals reported for severance taxes by year and region

The volume of all hardwood timber harvested annually in the 1970s peaked in 1971 at 507 MMBF (Figure 3), but there were no pronounced trends on a state or regional basis. The largest hardwood timber harvest was in the North Region in each year except 1977. The Delta Region produced very little pine timber but contributed about one fourth of the hardwood harvest in the State each year.




Figure 5. Mississippi hardwood pulpwood removals by year and region

The pine pulpwood harvest of 3.2 million cords in 1970 was the largest annual removal reported for the decade and resulted from the large volume salvaged in the South Region after Hurricane Camille in 1969. The Central Region dominated both pine and

hardwood pulpwood harvests during the 1970s (Figures 4 and 5). Pine pulpwood removals have been increasing in the North Region.

Reported harvests of pine and hardwood pulpwood in the Southwest Region remained relatively stable over the ten years.

### Harvests by County

Kemper County ranked first in pine timber and fifth in hardwood

timber removals while Clarke County led the State in both pine and hardwood pulpwood harvests during the 1970s (Tables 1 and 2).

The remaining tables in this report present the harvest volumes reported in the 1970s for each county, by product group and year.

REGIONS: ■ South ■ Southwest ■ Central ■ North ■ Delta
