## Origin Story

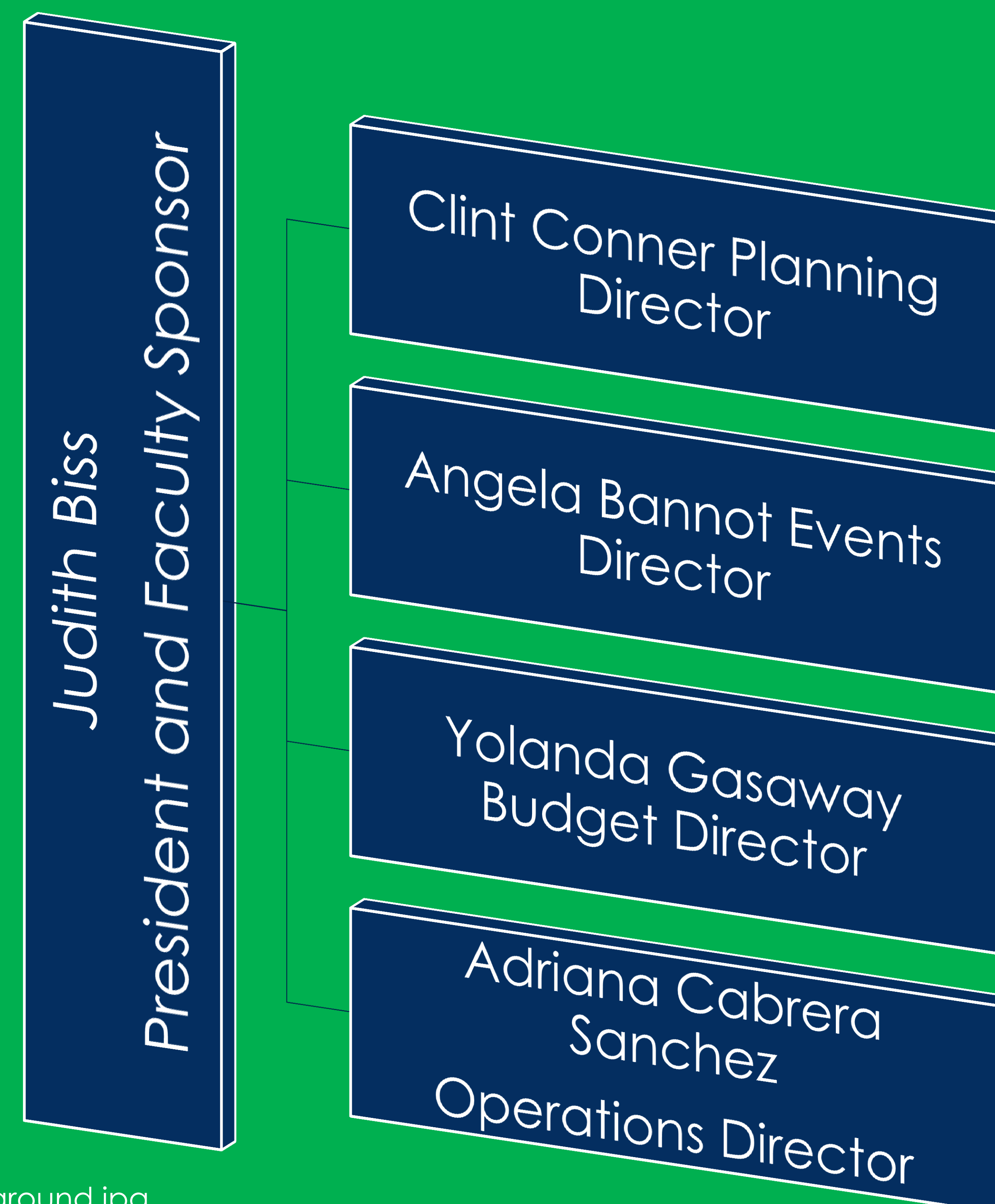
